St. Olaf Merit Scholarships

St. Olaf offers merit scholarships recognizing a wide range of student achievement. Prospective students may apply for merit awards in multiple areas, but must complete a separate scholarship application for each type of award. All applicants for the merit scholarships described below must first complete and submit an application for admission through the Common Application (www.commonapp.org) no later than January 15, 2010. (Early Decision 1 applicants must submit both applications no later than November 16, 2009.)

Please read the descriptions carefully to determine your eligibility and any additional materials required to apply for each award. Check the appropriate box to indicate which merit scholarship you seek.

St. Olaf Academic Scholarships (renewable awards of \$5,000 to \$14,000 per year)

St. Olaf Academic scholarships are based primarily on demonstrated superior academic achievement in high school and college entrance exams. Students applying for an academic scholarship must complete the essay on the following page and submit the online application on or before January 15, 2010. Award renewals are based on continued academic achievement.

St. Olaf Service Leadership Scholarships (renewable awards of \$6,000 per year)

St. Olaf Service Leadership scholarships are awarded to accepted students who demonstrate a depth of service and leadership in a variety of capacities. Students who wish to be considered for a St. Olaf service leadership scholarship must complete the essay on the following page, and submit a detailed résumé of involvement in community, school, and/or church. Résumés may be uploaded as an attachment during completion of the online merit scholarship application. The application and supporting materials must be submitted online on or before January 15, 2010. Award renewals are based on continued involvement in service leadership activities.

St. Olaf TRiO Scholarships (renewable awards of \$6,000 per year)

St. Olaf TRiO scholarships are awarded to students who meet two of the three federal TRiO guidelines (meet the federal low-income definition, are a first-generation college student, or live with a disability). Students who wish to be considered for a St. Olaf TRiO scholarship must complete the essay on the following page and submit the online application on or before January 15, 2010. Award renewals are based on academic, service, and co-curricular achievement.

Music Scholarships (renewable awards of \$4,000 to \$10,000 per year)

Music scholarships are available to both music majors and non-majors. To apply for a music scholarship, students must complete this application and provide an audition CD, music résumé, and an additional letter of recommendation. Please visit the music admissions web page for complete requirements (stolaf.edu/depts.music/admissions). All materials must be submitted on or before December 15, 2009. Note: this is significantly earlier than the regular decision application deadline for admission to the college. Renewals are based on continued involvement in music activities.

Merit Scholarship Essay
