Welcome to Skoglund Center for 2009-10 St. Olaf College men's basketball. Today, the Oles host Macalester College in the team's final home game of the season.

St. Olaf is coming off an overtime win over Gustavus on Wednesday while Macalester lost a 76-50 game to Concordia.

**Fong's 34-point, 11-rebound night lifts Oles past Gusties in overtime**  
Bobby Fong scored 34 points and had 11 rebounds as St. Olaf defeated Gustavus Adolphus College 77-69 in overtime on Wednesday night at Skoglund Center. Tucker Sheley added 13 points and Alfie Jaryan added nine and six rebounds for the Oles in the win, which snapped a six-game losing skid.

The Gusties had three players in double figures in the loss. Ryan McPartland led Gustavus with 18 points, while Phil Wirtjes added 14 and Tyler Grey had 10. Fong's career night came on 12-of-22 shooting from the field. He was 9-for-13 at the line and had seven points in overtime.

St. Olaf trailed by as many as 15 in the first half and by 12 at the break. The Oles used a 16-3 run to turn an eight-point deficit to a five-point lead with 1:47 left. The Gusties then countered with the last five points of regulation on a lay-up by McPartland and three-pointer by Wirtjes.

## Macalester Notes

The Scots (2-21, 0-18 MIAC), who have lost their last 46 league games, played second-place Augsburg to a 3-point game last week. Macalester has been led by Pierce Peters (10.3 ppg).
