

Minutes of December 2, 1997 ACPB Meeting

Computer Access Policy:

ACPB members reviewed a draft version of the access policy and guidelines and formally adopted a final version. The new policy makes no changes in access for current students and staff or for current and emeriti faculty. It does change the access for graduates (continued accounts and user privileges will be granted for up to 3 months) and former employees (no access). The new policy and guidelines will be given to Dean Pence who will be asked to inform SALT. It will also be put in the ACC Newsletter.

Updates from Roberta:

- *Mailing Lists:* Roberta spelled out exactly which mailing lists had been cut off temporarily (only those for majors); these will be reinstated as soon as moderators are appointed. She also spelled out how some of the other mailing lists are handled.
- *Use of Public Computer Labs:* Most public labs are operating at capacity much of the time. Registration surveys indicate that students want more computers and laser printers available, particularly in residence halls. The ACC may set up terminals limited to e-mail use. They are considering the possibility of a card system giving students a certain amount of free printing (additional printing to be paid for by the student); this would make the location of laser printers in dorms more feasible. There also appears to be a need for more training for residential hall computer assistants.
- *Equipment Requests:* Roberta is notifying departments and academic offices of decisions on their equipment requests.
