

## **Minutes of Feb. 26, 1997 ACPB meeting**

**Approved March 12, 1997**

### **Report on Roberta's meeting with Jim Pence**

Roberta reported that Pence again indicated strong support for the activities of the ACC. Pence wants ACPB to carefully consider and act on the results of the Faculty Teaching and Technology Survey. In particular, they discussed possible faculty mentor programs. Roberta will meet with Pence once a month on a regular basis.

### **Other issues addressed:**

1. Tony reported on his conversations with Tom White about setting up "academic" web pages and the appropriate criteria for these.
2. Marc reported that Jim May currently doesn't have sufficient faculty development funds to give honoraria to faculty who conduct web workshops.
3. Roberta reported that the most recent cost estimate for wiring the remaining two residence halls is over twice as much as a previous estimate. However the recent estimate includes better grade wiring and moving the jacks away from the room doors to more convenient locations.
