

## **Minutes of March 12, 1997 ACPB meeting**

### **Humanities and Applied Sciences Curriculum Computing Grant Proposals:**

The ACPB received only one such proposal, from the Speech/Theater Department. It was approved. The remaining money designated for these grants will be added to the academic equipment budget and used to fund classroom display units requested under this budget.

### **Consideration of Teaching and Technology Issues:**

Considerable time was spent brainstorming effective ways to support and increase the use of technology in teaching. The recent Teaching and Technology Survey indicated widespread interest among the faculty in learning more about computing technology. Members of ACPB decided to solicit ideas from their faculty colleagues. Roberta will bring the question to the faculty group that drafted the survey and will ask Jim Pence for advice. Roberta will also send ACPB members copies of a couple of articles addressing this topic. One of the major questions that needs to be considered is how we can give faculty support for developing and mentoring technology uses.

### **Other Items:**

Roberta has sent a memo to Jim Pence asking SALT to advise the ACC on how to proceed on wiring the two remaining residence halls in view of the vast difference in the two price quotes received.
