4/10/00 Meeting

Members present: Allen, Becker, Lembke and Roberts

- 1). Minutes of 4/3/00 meeting were approved.
- 2). Craig Rice and Mike Sjulstad from the ACC were present to discuss the following issues relating to increased level of Network Traffic:
 - A. Current packet filter security system and the future possibility of a firewall.
 - B. Increased recreational use of computers by students and its negative impact upon network traffic.
 - C. ICQ, a real-time chat program, which is popular with students but poses a network security problem to St. Olaf.
 - D. Even with added T1 line, the network band width is still reaching maximum capacity during peak usage hours (30% of which appears to be recreational use coming from residence halls).
- 3). ACPB recommends the ACC explore internet traffic management options with any trials of new software end by May 8, due to the schedule of final exams.
- 4). Discussed Faculty Survey on Issues Relating to Technology document. ACPB will continue adding to/editing the list of issues until the document is ready to be sent to faculty.
- 5). Discussed Ownership of Materials document.
 - An introduction addressing the necessity for such a document will be incorporated into the document.
 - The use of College resources, especially technology support for multi-media projects needs to be addressed.
