

Academic Computer Policy Board

Meeting of May 15, 2002

Present: Bob Jacobel, Roberta Lembke, Dolores Peters and Barbara Reed

The main item of business for the meeting was to consider questions about the Mailing Lists Policy Announcement after the committee received comments from Staff Council. Committee members thought it was important to convey the long-term process of consideration that went into recommended changes, and modified the rationale paragraph accordingly.

Members also affirmed a strong commitment to having the stolaf-faculty alias remain just that. We discussed the inclusion of various part-time teaching categories, shared appointments, coaching, AAA's and senior members of the administration. Persons who are teaching courses part-time at the college during an academic term should be added to stolaf-faculty by virtue of being members of departments. They need to be removed from the list when teaching duties are completed. The President and other senior members of the administration are included in stolaf-faculty and their inclusion will be made clear in the descriptor for the alias. AAA's will have access to information from college offices: the Registrar, Business Office, etc., by inclusion of the aaa alias in official communications from those offices. Roberta announced that the Sabbatical Leave memo, offering to exchange and store hard drives and other information about computer use during leaves, was about to go out.

The group discussed committee membership for 2002-2004 and made recommendations based on responses from the community.

Roberta described a number of the summer projects being undertaken by IIT, workshops planned, construction and plans for staff reorganization.
