

Minutes of September 23, 1997 ACPB Meeting

Continued Access to the St. Olaf Computer System: Members of the policy board spent almost the entire meeting discussing possible changes to the current policy. Emeriti faculty and staff now have continued limited access, while graduates and employees who leave the college currently have access for up to twelve months following their departure. With the increasing demands on the system and on ACC personnel, it is necessary to make further restrictions on computer access for former employees and graduates. Since private internet service is now reasonably priced and widely available, people who leave St. Olaf can still obtain internet access. Roberta will ask for input from Alan Norton, Jim Pence and Roger Loftus and ACPB will continue this discussion. Any suggested changes will need to be reviewed by SALT and possibly by Dean's Council.

Faculty Enhancement Opportunities: Roberta indicated that several faculty enhancement opportunities are planned. Over fall break, ACC will give 2 Power Point presentations. There may also be sessions on Web pages and the use of Excel for grades. Over interim break, the ACC is planning a technology fair for faculty. Members of ACPB were asked to suggest names of faculty who would be able to give presentations or be panel members.
