

CEPC Minutes 3/31/04

Meeting convened at 3:33 PM

1. CEPC approved the minutes for the 3/24/04 meeting.
2. Steve Hahn, chair of the Special Studies Subcommittee presented for CEPC's consideration five new course proposals. Accepting the recommendations made by the Special Studies Subcommittee, CEPC approved all five courses, yet proposed that minor editorial changes should be made to the catalogue statements and titles of some of the courses. S. Hahn is expected to consult with the proposers of those courses to come up with mutually acceptable alternative language. Those five courses were:
 - Norwegian 130: Rebelling Against Traditions: Love, Sex, and Family in Nordic Films Today
 - Education 314: Social Studies in Elementary Classrooms
 - Education 315: Reading, Communication, and Literacy Methods
 - Education 316: Science, Health, and Active Living
 - Education 317: Mathematics for Elementary Classrooms
3. Alice Hanson, chair of the Honorary Degree Committee, presented a motion that the College should nominate one individual for an honorary degree, to be conferred at a ceremony next fall. After a brief discussion, CEPC approved the motion. The Honorary Degree Committee will then present the same motion to the faculty, and, if the faculty approves the motion, to the Board of Regents to obtain their approval.
4. Lastly, Mary Cisar introduced to CEPC proposed revisions to the College's academic policies as they related to Incompletes, Audits, Deadlines, Interim, and course credit overloads. CEPC will discuss the proposed revisions more fully at a later meeting.
