

Committee on the Status of Women (from the St. Olaf Faculty Manual)

- a. General purpose is to improve in a general way the conditions for all women of the St. Olaf community.
- b. Responsibilities include:
 - 1) To facilitate communication among various parts of the St. Olaf community in regard to women's issues.
 - 2) To review and recommend necessary changes in formal college policies through appropriate channels.
 - 3) To confer with the Coordinator of Women's Studies.
 - 4) To encourage discussion of women's issues throughout the college community.
- c. Personnel:
 - 1) Six faculty representatives
 - 2) Two members of the administration
 - 3) Two support staff members
 - 4) Three students
 - 5) The Dean of Students
 - 6) The Title IX coordinator
- d. Term of Office:
 - 1) Members shall be appointed by the President for one-year renewable terms with a view to having some members serve more than one year.
