

## **General Education Committee**

### **Minutes for November 14, 2001**

The Chair called the meeting to order at 3:30.

Minutes for November 7th meeting were approved without changes.

The chair made several announcements, one relating to a slightly different "New Course Proposal" cover sheet. There were no objections to the change.

The committee approved a student petition for ORC credit for an independent study. The petition prompted a discussion about whether "ignorance of the guidelines" by either a professor or student should be sufficient reason for an exemption. The committee will revisit this issue.

**GEC #810 (Music 233 Music in Context)** was approved for ALS-A (as an on-campus rather than an off-campus course).

**GEC #832 (History 220 Reformation England, 1485-1714)** was approved for HWC.

**GEC #507 (Biology 226 Terrestrial Ecology in Australia)** was postponed pending more detailed information.
