Minutes for April 3, 2002

Members Present: Alison Feldt (Chair, FA), Bruce Dalgaard (IGS), John Day (IGS, Assoc. Dean), Jill Dietz (NSM), Naurine Lennox (SAS), Steve Reece (HUM), and Niels Knutson (Student, voting).

The Chair called the meeting to order at 3:23 pm.

Minutes for the March 20, 2002 meeting were approved without changes.

The Chair announced that the April 10, 2002 meeting will be joint with CEPC. Jo Beld will present information gathered by the Gold Form Advisory Committee. The meeting will be held in Buntrock 143 at 3:20 pm.

The Chair announced that **English 233** has previously been approved for ALS-L credit, so GEC need not consider the issue.

The committee proofed parts of the 2000-2002 catalog pertaining to GE matters. The following items should be changed for the 2002-2004 catalog:

1. On p. 6, the 4th bullet concerning ORC should be changed to: "One course that develops oral communication competence and confidence, available in a variety of disciplines;"
2. On p. 6, 3rd paragraph from the bottom, 2nd line: "First Year Seminar" should be changed to "First Year Writing course"
3. On p. 60, bottom of the page: parentheses in the EIN description should be closed.

Rationale for the changes above:

1. Reflects the fact that there no longer exist .25-credit ORC courses.
2. "First Year Seminar" is not the title of GE 111.
3. Parentheses should always be closed.

Other Matters:

- Reece asked why there are no written guidelines for BTS-B.
- The Chair will invite several people to attend a GEC meeting on either April 17 or April 24 to discuss MCS-D.
