

Committee on Services to the Handicapped (from the St. Olaf College Faculty Manual)

- a. The purpose of the committee is to identify areas in which reasonable accommodation may be needed to provide equal opportunity for students and employees with disabilities. The committee also sponsors speakers and events to educate the college community about the abilities of people with disabilities.
- b. Personnel:
 - 1) Three faculty members
 - 2) A representative from the Admissions Office
 - 3) A representative from the Academic Support Center
 - 4) The Equal Opportunity Coordinator
 - 5) Three students
 - 6) A representative from the Counseling Center
- c. Term of Office:
 - 1) Members shall be appointed by the President for one-year renewable terms with a view to having some members serve more than one year.
