New Business

1. Patrick Quade updated the committee on a few items:
  - a. CEPC approved providing International students with a stole to wear at commencement, which will signify that they are International Students.
  - b. 295 students will be notified today that they are accepted for 1999-2000 Off-Campus semester and yearlong programs.
  - c. Three students and one faculty member have been invited to visit the School of the Americas in Georgia on April 19, 1999.
  - d. ID 233: Comparative Medical Systems for January 2000 in Europe has been canceled.
2. Econ 218: Economic Progress in China has been given final approval for the 2000 interim.
3. The National Institutes of Health in Bethesda, MD sponsored by Colgate College has been approved for pilot status.
4. The London School of Economics program has been approved for pilot status.
5. Phyllis Larson presented and handed out materials to IDOCS on two Japanese semester and yearlong exchange programs. Ferris University was approved for pilot status. Doshisha University will be looked at for the future because more work needs to be done with the cost of the program.
6. The course proposal for the 2000-2001 Term in Asia program was reviewed. The course was approved with a few recommendations for the catalog statement and the rationale. Pat Quade will work with Mary Griep on the finalized proposal.
7. The April 15, 1999 IDOCS meeting was cancelled. The next meeting will be on April 22, 1999.
