

**Nominating Committee** (from the St. Olaf College Faculty Manual)

- a. General purpose is to serve as the faculty nominating committee.
- b. Responsibilities include:
  - 1) To serve as the nominating committee for:
    - a) Elected faculty committees.
    - b) Faculty Observer to the Board of Regents.
    - c) Regents-Faculty Conference Committee.
    - d) The Honor Council Advisor.
    - e) Faculty Athletic Representative.
    - f) Secretary of the Faculty.
    - g) Parliamentarian.
  - 2) To select hearing committees as specified under Dismissal Proceedings (Section 4.XVII).
  - 3) To coordinate the elections of Faculties' representatives to all elected committees and offices.
- c. Personnel:
  - 1) Five faculty representatives, one elected by each of the Faculties
  - 2) The Dean or Dean's designate

The term of office for elected faculty representatives shall be two years. The terms shall be staggered.
