On April 21, 2007, when the Red Bulls beat the Dynamo despite playing a man down for 50-plus minutes. Clint Mathis was sent off in the 36th minute for a reckless challenge, and at that point, the score was still 0-0 – thanks to a missed penalty kick by Mathis. But Jozy Altidore came through in the clutch, getting on the receiving end of a Hunter Freeman cross and burying it in the 60th minute.

On August 10, 2008, when the Red Bulls defeated D.C. United, 4-1, at Giants Stadium. Though Jaime Moreno put United ahead in the first half, Juan Pablo Angel and Mike Magee scored before the break to put the Red Bulls up, 2-1. Angel found the back of the net five minutes after the half before Sinisa Ubiparipovic scored his first career goal to give New York their biggest win over D.C. United.

REMEMBER WHEN?

On July 22, 2007, when the Red Bulls last defeated D.C. United at Giants Stadium. John Wolyniec scored the only goal the home team would need in the 1-0 decision, and the win for New York was the club's first win over D.C. since Oct. 8, 2005 at RFK Stadium.
