

Distinction in Environmental Studies

The Environmental Studies Program seeks to honor those among its graduating majors who have demonstrated outstanding scholarship and creativity during their years at St. Olaf. As criteria for distinction, the ES faculty will consider a student's record of academic achievement from courses within the program together with work from a significant project done beyond the required curriculum. The latter may take a variety of forms from a scientific research project to a work of art. The project should demonstrate both excellence and creativity and will involve public presentation or publication. Because scholarship is also a primary criterion, ES Majors seeking Distinction are advised not to take any of their ES coursework pass no-credit (S/U). Those who wish to be considered for Distinction by the Program should consult the ES Program Director by March 15th of their Senior Year.
