Distinction in Environmental Studies

The Environmental Studies Department seeks to honor those among its graduating majors who have demonstrated outstanding scholarship and creativity during their years at St. Olaf.* As criteria for distinction, the ES faculty will consider a student's record of academic achievement from courses within the program together with work from a significant project done beyond the required curriculum. The latter may take a variety of forms from a scientific research project to a work of art. The project should demonstrate both excellence and creativity and will involve public presentation or publication. Because scholarship is also a primary criterion, ES Majors seeking Distinction are advised not to take any of their ES coursework pass no-credit (S/U). Those who wish to be considered for Distinction by the Department should consult the ES Chair by March 15th of their Senior Year.

* Students interested in seeking distinction should examine the description in the college catalog; this establishes the general characteristics for all potential candidates across the institution.
