# GERMAN IN THE WORKPLACE:

## *Academic Internship Program in Paderborn, Germany*

This international academic internship program is designed exclusively for St. Olaf students who have completed German 232 or the equivalent. The program will give up to 15 students the opportunity to practice and improve their German in a real-life environment and gather work experience. Students will reside with German Rotary families during their time abroad.

Students will shadow a German professional in his/her workplace four days a week for four weeks. Every Monday they will meet for an intensive language course at the university. Language instruction runs from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. with an hour lunch break in between. The language course will cater to the students' particular needs and will be an addition to "Deutsch im Beruf." While most weekends will be open for students to travel independently, our colleagues at the University of Paderborn have planned a two-day trip to Germany's capital of Berlin one of the weekends. The academic credit internship can be combined with FLAC credit for a full German credit.

### **ACADEMIC CREDIT AND COSTS**

Those accepted into the program will have the option of doing either a 1.0 credit or 0.5 credit academic internship. 0.5 credit summer internship tuition: \$955

For 0.5 credit, total program costs to the student will be approx \$3,495\*

For 1.0 credit, total program costs to the student will be approx \$4,455\*

Create a résumé (in German) and a short letter of interest (in English). In your letter of interest, list your top 3 internship site choices and describe your career goals/interests.
