

Entrance Requirements for Music Education: Music Dept.*

- ❑ Overall and content GPA averages of 2.7 or better
- ❑ Current enrollment in or completion of Mu 251 (Conducting) with good performance (rubric available from the instructor)
- ❑ Completion of Mu 211, 213, and 241 (music core courses) with good academic performance
- ❑ Satisfactory progress in Mu 212, 214 and 242
- ❑ Successful performance in primary performing medium at designated Thursday recital. (Students must also perform successfully in secondary medium, if primary is keyboard, since keyboard is not a licensure-related instrument) Most students perform their entrance recital during March of Year Two.
- ❑ Support from the music faculty
- ❑ Satisfactory progress toward keyboard proficiency

Dr. Berger and the Music Office have copies of rubrics used to evaluate recital performances, conducting class progress, and keyboard proficiency. A student who fails to meet the music dept. criteria for entrance at the usual time may usually re-apply for entrance during the fall of Year Three. The date for the Thursday Entrance Recital for this school year will be Tuesday, March 18, 2008. **Be sure to notify your studio teacher(s)** well in advance, if you need to perform on the Entrance Recital.

Continuance Requirements for Music Education: Music Dept.*

- ❑ Overall and content GPA averages of 2.7 or better
- ❑ Satisfactory progress in Ed. 330, including micro-teaching performance
- ❑ Completion of the keyboard proficiency requirement
- ❑ Successful performance in primary performing medium at designated Thursday recital. (Students must also perform successfully in secondary medium, if primary is keyboard, since keyboard is not a licensure-related instrument). Most students perform their continuance recital during November of Year Three.
- ❑ Successful completion of music theory and music history survey (241 and 242) courses
- ❑ Support from the music faculty

Dr. Berger and the Music office have copies of rubrics used to evaluate recital performances, micro-teaching, keyboard proficiency, and guitar proficiency. A student who fails to meet the music dept. criteria for continuance may usually be considered again in the spring of Year Three. The date for the Thursday Continuance Recital for this school year will be Tuesday, November 6, 2007. **Be sure to notify your studio teacher(s)** well in advance, if you need to perform on the Continuance Recital.

Before a student may student teach, guitar proficiency must be demonstrated during Ed. 356, keyboard proficiency requirement completed, and all other criteria of the music and education departments must be met.
