- I understand that if I am chosen as the Resident Assistant for the Norwegian House, I will lead House activities in cooperation with the Norwegian House President, and speak and encourage others to speak Norwegian at all times when in the House.
- Further, I realize that being the Resident Assistant means that I will work 10 hours per week with duties in the Norwegian House and in the Norwegian Department. I will organize monthly activities to promote Norwegian language and culture on campus, lead the weekly language table, arrange weekly House meetings, lead Norwegian discussion groups, and do other tasks as needed by the Norwegian Department.
- I understand that this position is regarded as a scholarship award which covers room, board, fees, and tuition. Board is provided in the College cafeteria and room at the Norwegian House. Room and board are not provided during long vacation breaks (such as Christmas and Spring vacations). Tuition covers the cost of instruction (courses), but not the cost of textbooks. All travel is at the expense of the Assistant.
- I agree to be in residence at the Norwegian House from the beginning of Fall semester through the end of the Spring semester, including the January interim.
- I agree not to take other work for remuneration, on- or off-campus, during the period of the Assistantship.
- I agree to follow all rules and regulations that the College has set down regarding residential life, including those related to alcohol, intervisitation, and pets.
- I understand that failure to comply with House / College rules or failure to work the appropriate hours for the Norwegian Department means possible renegotiation of this contract.
