**Dr. Andrew Mast** is assistant professor of music and director of bands at the Lawrence University Conservatory of Music, a position he has held since the fall of 2004. He conducts the Wind Ensemble and Symphonic Band while teaching courses in band history, conducting and the freshman studies program. Prior to his appointment at Lawrence, he was Director of Bands at St. Ambrose University in Davenport, Iowa, where he conducted the Symphonic Band and University/Community Orchestra, taught conducting and music education classes and served as department chair. He also conducted the Quad City Wind Ensemble and founded the Quad City Area Youth Wind Symphony. He has been recognized for his teaching via the Young Teacher Award at Lawrence in 2009 and the Faculty of the Year award at St. Ambrose in 2004.

Bands under his direction have appeared at several conferences, including the College Band Directors National Association North Central region and the Wisconsin Music Educators Association. In May of 2006 he was a guest conductor for the Pilsen Conservatory in the Czech Republic and during the summers of 2002-04, he was on the conducting faculty of the Interlochen Arts Camp. Mast taught for seven years in the public schools of Iowa and Minnesota, teaching at the elementary, middle and high school levels of instrumental music.

Dr. Mast's professional affiliations include the College Band Director's National Association, National Band Association and the World Association of Symphonic Bands and Ensembles. He is a co-founder and President of the Vincent Persichetti Society. He has made scholarly contributions to *The Instrumentalist, Journal of Band Research*, the *Teaching Music Through Performance in Band* series and *The Annals of Iowa*. He and his wife Melissa have a son Sam, a daughter Sophie, and a beagle Max.



**Dana Maeda** graduated from St. Olaf College with a B.M. degree in oboe performance, vocal and instrumental education. She then earned an M.A. in education from St. Mary's University. Her primary oboe teachers include Julie Madura and Rhadames Angelucci. In addition to over 20 years as a private instructor, she has previously served on the faculties of Bethel University and Crown College.

Maeda spent 14 years in the public and private schools teaching band, choir and classroom music. Her experiences have included instruction at the high school, middle school, and elementary levels. The last nine years were devoted to elementary classroom music instruction with an emphasis on early childhood development.

Maeda currently performs with the Rochester Symphony Orchestra and Chorale and is a founding member of WindWorks Woodwind Quintet. She is active as a free-lance performer in the Twin Cities area. Some of her diverse performances include The Bach Society of Minnesota, Minnesota Sinfonia, Minneapolis Pops Orchestra, Arius Chamber Music Society, Minnetonka Choral Society, and The Moody Blues. Maeda frequently assumes the coaching/clinician role. These opportunities have included high school master classes on the art of chamber music, judging regional solo/ensemble competitions, and woodwind coach for the Minnesota All-State Orchestra. In addition to working with the St. Olaf oboe studio, she also coaches chamber ensembles and teaches woodwind methods.



**Dr. Timothy Mahr**, professor of music and conductor of the St. Olaf Band, teaches courses in composition, music education and conducting, and supervises instrumental student teaching. A graduate of St. Olaf College, he is a past-president of the North Central Division of the College Band Directors National Association and has served on the Board of Directors of the National Band Association and the Minnesota Band Directors Association. He was inducted into the American Bandmasters Association in 1993.

Mahr is active as a guest conductor and clinician and has been in residence as a guest composer/conductor on over 35 college and university campuses. He has been invited to conduct all state bands in over 20 states and ensembles in Europe, Mexico, Canada and Southeast Asia. He is also the principal conductor of the Minnesota Symphonic Winds, an ensemble recently featured in performance at the 2008 Midwest Clinic in Chicago. Ensembles worldwide have performed his compositions. Notable commissions include works for the Music Educators National Conference, the United States Air Force Band, the American Bandmasters Association and a work to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the American School Band Directors Association. He received the 1991 ABA/Ostwald Award for his work, *The Soaring Hawk*.

The St. Olaf Band performed at the 1997 American Bandmasters Association Convention in San Diego and at the 2004 Music Educators National Conference in Minneapolis. The band completed its fifth tour of England in June 2000, a study tour of Mexico in January 2004, and recently joined the St. Olaf Choir and St. Olaf Orchestra in a tour of Norway in June 2005. They will be taking a study tour of Japan in January 2010.



**Dr. Paul Niemisto**, associate professor of music, teaches low brass instruments, conducts brass ensembles, the Norseman Band, and teaches courses in music education. He is a graduate of the University of Michigan and the University of Minnesota. Niemisto is founder and director of the American Poijat (Boys of America), a widely traveled Finnish American brass ensemble. He is also founder and conductor of the Cannon Valley Regional Orchestra, a community symphony orchestra based in Northfield, celebrating its 30th anniversary this season.

Since 1980, Niemisto has been traveling regularly to Finland, where he has taught and conducted at numerous institutes and conservatories. In the spring of 1999, he was a Fulbright senior fellow at the Finnish War Archives and Helsinki University Library. In 2006, he organized and hosted the International Wind Music History Conference and the Vintage Band Festival, held in Northfield, Minnesota. This event will be repeated in August 2010.
