BIOGRAPHIES

Dr. Russel C. Mikkelsen serves as Director of University Bands, Professor of Music (Conducting) and Area Head of Conducting and Ensembles at The Ohio State University, where he conducts the Wind Symphony, chairs the graduate conducting program, and oversees all aspects of the university's band program. Under his direction, the OSU Wind Symphony has performed at the 2003 College Band Directors National Association Convention, the 2001, 2004, 2006, 2008 and 2011 Ohio Music Educators Association Conventions, and has recorded four CD's: **Southern Harmony** (Naxos, 2009), **Winds of Nagual** (Naxos, 2007), **Jubilare!** (Mark Records, 2003) and **Sounds, Shapes and Symbols** (Mark Records, 2000). In a 2010 review of the *Southern Harmony* recording, *Fanfare* magazine proclaims, "The Ohio State musicians play their collective hearts out and conductor Mikkelsen shapes the music with a loving hand, wringing every last drop of emotion out of the music. If this does not give you goose-bumps, nothing will."

Director of the OSU Contemporary Music Festival and a staunch advocate for the creation of new works, Mikkelsen also serves on the American Bandmasters Association Commissioning Committee and has instituted a program of regular commissioning projects for the OSU Bands. He has received praise from composers Leslie Bassett, Krzysztof Penderecki, John Corigliano, Michael Colgrass, Jennifer Higdon, Gunther Schuller, Lukas Foss, Augusta Read Thomas, Frank Ticheli, and Michael Daugherty, among others, for his musical realization of their compositions. Corigliano wrote, "Russel Mikkelsen is a conductor who really understands my music, and that's rare."

Dr. Mikkelsen is Past President of the Big Ten Band Directors Association, a member of the College Band Directors National Association, MENC, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, Phi Beta Mu, and is an elected member of the American Bandmasters Association. An enthusiastic advocate of public school music education, Dr. Mikkelsen has conducted All-State Bands, Festivals, and Honor Bands across the United States and internationally. He was the recipient of the 2005 Ohio State University School of Music Distinguished Scholar Award and has published articles in *The Instrumentalist* and *The Journal of the Conductor's Guild*. As a composer/arranger, he is published through C. Alan and Daehn Publications.

Dr. Timothy Mahr, professor of music and conductor of the St. Olaf Band, teaches courses in composition, music education and conducting, and supervises instrumental student teaching. A 1978 graduate of St. Olaf College, he is a past-president of the North Central Division of the College Band Directors National Association and has served on the Board of Directors of the National Band Association and the Minnesota Band Directors Association. He earned his M.A. and D.M.A. from The University of Iowa. Mahr was inducted into the American Bandmasters Association in 1993.

Mahr is active as a guest conductor and clinician and has been in residence as a guest composer/conductor on over 35 college and university campuses. He has been invited to conduct all-state and intercollegiate bands in over 25 states and ensembles in Europe, Mexico, Canada, and Southeast Asia. He is the principal conductor of the Minnesota Symphonic Winds, an ensemble recently featured in performance at the 2008 Midwest Clinic in Chicago and the recipient of the 2009 Sudler Silver Scroll Award from the John Philip Sousa Foundation. Ensembles worldwide have performed his compositions. Notable commissions include works for the Music Educators National Conference, the United States Air Force Band, the American Bandmasters Association, and a work to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the American School Band Directors Association. He received the 1991 ABA/Ostwald Award for his work, *The Soaring Hawk*.

The St. Olaf Band performed at the 1997 American Bandmasters Association Convention in San Diego and at the 2004 Music Educators National Conference in Minneapolis. This coming March, the St. Olaf Band will present an invited performance at the National Conference of the College Band Directors National Association. The band completed its fifth tour of England in June 2000, a study tour of Mexico in January 2004, joined the St. Olaf Choir and St. Olaf Orchestra in a tour of Norway in June 2005, and participated in a study tour of Japan in January 2010.

William Webb, 2012-13 interim conductor of the Norseman Band, has directed bands in Minnesota for 34 years, 24 of those years at Edina High School. For the past two years, Bill has thoroughly enjoyed teaching 5th grade beginning band students in Edina. Webb has been awarded the Minnesota Music Educators Association's "2011 Educator of the Year", the Greater Twin Cities Youth Symphonies' "2004 School Music Teacher of the Year", and Edina High School's "1991 Excellence in Education Award". Webb is a founding officer and past president of the Minnesota Band Directors Association, has served as president of the Minnesota chapter of Phi Beta Mu, president of the Evergreen Club, and has served for six years on the MMEA Board of Directors and four years on the Minnesota State High School League Board of Directors.

For the past 25 years, Webb has served as the associate conductor of the Minnesota Symphonic Winds, an adult community band based in Edina, founded by Miles Johnson and currently conducted by Timothy Mahr. For over 30 years, Mr. Webb has led thousands of students on music tours throughout the United States, Europe, the Caribbean, Hong Kong, Singapore, and China. Webb is a 1977 graduate of The College of St. Thomas and obtained his Masters of Music Education degree at the VanderCook College of Music in Chicago, Illinois.

Dr. Martin Hodel has performed as a soloist, chamber musician and orchestral player in the United States and around the world. During the 2005-06 season he played full time in the trumpet section of the Minnesota Orchestra, with whom he has recorded and plays extra. As Principal and Solo Trumpet with the Eastman Wind Ensemble, Hodel toured the United States and Japan, and he has toured coast to coast in America with the Dallas Brass. He has also shared the stage with jazz artists Joe Henderson, Maria Schneider, Slide Hampton, Claudio Roditi, David Murray, and Jimmy Heath, and has toured Germany with organist Bradley Lehman as part of the Hodel-Lehman Duo. A CD by the Duo, *In Thee is Gladness*, recorded in Emden, Germany has been released on Larips Records. Hodel appears as a soloist on seven other compact discs, has performed live on the nationally-broadcast radio program, *A Prairie Home Companion*, on Minnesota Public Radio, on public television, and on national broadcasts of the radio programs *Sing for Joy* and *PipeDreams*. Since 1997 he has been the trumpet professor at St. Olaf College in Northfield, Minnesota. Hodel holds a doctorate in trumpet performance and a performer's certificate from the Eastman School of Music, a master of music from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, and a bachelor's degree in music education from Goshen College. His teachers have included Charles Geyer, Barbara Butler, Allen Vizzutti, James Ketch, Raymond Mase, Craig Heitger, David Hickman and Anthony Plog. On a recent sabbatical, Hodel studied Baroque (natural, valveless) trumpet and 18th-century trumpet literature in Europe with Dr. Edward H. Tarr, the leading expert on early trumpets and trumpet literature.
