692 seniors have declared 915 majors.

478 (69%) seniors have declared **one major**, 205 (30%) have declared **two majors**, and 9 (1%) have declared **three majors**.

As of today, 376 seniors out of 692 will graduate with **honors** (54%).

Of the 692 seniors, 489 or 71% participated in at least one **off-campus Domestic or International program** (Year, Semester, or Interim).
