Off-Campus Study

Of the 696 seniors, 535 or 76.8% participated in at least one **off-campus Domestic or International program** (Year, Semester, or Interim). 213 (30.6%) participated in two or more programs.

Domestic off-campus programs – 137 students, 19.6% participation

International off-campus programs – 470 students, 67.5% participation
