Massachusetts Promise Fellows deliver the resources that young people need to be successful in life by **mobilizing** and **organizing** community activity, **creating** and **leading** powerful initiatives, and **training** and **inspiring** citizen volunteers.

The **Massachusetts Promise Fellowship** achieves this by hiring, training, and supporting Fellows placed with non-profit organizations, schools, and state/local government agencies across the Commonwealth. During a year of full-time service, Fellows focus on fulfilling the development needs of our youth by: 1) supporting young leaders and youth leadership programs and projects, 2) establishing new mentor/mentee matches, 3) leading youth education and outreach activities, 4) coordinating out-of-school enrichment activities, and 5) managing youth and adult volunteers.
