Ohio Historical Marker Honors Erie Sauder

A listener from Bluffton, Ohio sent us a clipping from The Toledo Blade (June 10, 2002) reporting that the Ohio Historical Society has authorized a historical marker honoring Erie Sauder. The marker appears near the entrance to Sauder Village, Archbold, Ohio. Quoting from the clipping: "The marker sums up the pioneer furniture manufacturer and philanthropist's contribution to the community. In 1934, he opened Sauder Woodworking Co. out of his Archbold barn. In 1951, Mr. Sauder invented an easy-to-ship table kit, ushering in the ready-to-assemble furniture industry. In 1976, he founded Sauder Village. He died in 1997."
