He is the founder of the Drake University Wind Symphony, an ensemble that, since its inception in 1998, has received national recognition for excellence in live performance and recordings. They've released seven CD recordings through Mark Custom Recording, and have given invited performances for the North Central Division of College Band Directors National Association (2000, 2008, 2012), the Iowa Bandmasters Association (1999, 2006, 2012), and the North American Saxophone Alliance (2005). Meunier was elected to membership in the American Bandmasters

Association in 2014, and is a past-president of the Iowa Bandmasters Association. He has been a member of the Des Moines Symphony Orchestra percussion section for 28 years.

Her primary oboe teachers include Julie Madura and Rhadames Angelucci. A school educator and studio instructor for 30 years, Dana has worked with students from pre-school through retirement age. Dana is an instructor at St. Olaf College where her responsibilities are the oboe studio, woodwind methods, chamber music, directing the Collegium Musicum (Renaissance wind ensembles), and supervision of instrumental student teacher candidates. A founding 23-year member of the WindWorks Woodwind

Quintet and 20-year member of the Rochester Symphony, Dana has many opportunities to perform in the Twin Cities and greater Minnesota. She has performed with Minneapolis Pops Orchestra, Bach Society of Minnesota, Arius, Minnetonka Choral Society, Minnesota Sinfonia, and The Moody Blues. In addition to participating in the St. Olaf Festival of Bands as a guest lecturer and featured soloist, Dana has presented master classes on the art of chamber music, judged regional solo/ensemble competitions, and coached for the Minnesota All-State Bands and Orchestras.



**Timothy Mahr** holds a B.M. degree in composition and a B.A. degree in music education from St. Olaf College, as well as a master's degree in trombone performance, and a D.M.A. in instrumental conducting from The University of Iowa. He was elected to the American Bandmasters Association in 1993. An internationally acclaimed composer, Dr. Mahr received the 1991 Ostwald Award in the ABA Band Composition Contest for his work, *The Soaring Hawk*. Formerly director of bands at the University of Minnesota-Duluth and founding conductor of the Twin Ports Wind Ensemble, Dr. Mahr is the principal conductor of the Minnesota Symphonic Winds and is active as a clinician and guest conductor nationally and internationally.
