# BIOGRAPHIES

Lieutenant Colonel R. Michael Mench assumed the position of Chief, Air Force Bands Division, Secretary of the Air Force, Public Affairs on 1 September, 2016. A native of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, Lt. Col. Mench began his Air Force career in 1997. Stationed in Texas, Washington D.C., California, Ohio, and Germany, Lt. Col.l Mench led Air Force musical ensembles across the United States and into countries like Costa Rica, Colombia, Nicaragua, Belarus, the Republic of Georgia, Slovakia, and has sent groups across Europe and Africa, including throughout the Baltics, Balkins, Tunisia, Botswana, Mauritania, and Rwanda to only name a few. He brought the Air Force image with music to kings and orphans, presidents and everyday people, rich and poor. Lt. Col. Mench's military decorations include the Meritorious Service Medal with two oak leaf clusters, the Air Force Commendation Medal with one oak leaf cluster, the Air Force Achievement Medal, the Navy/Marine Corps Achievement Medal, the National Defense Service Medal, and the Humanitarian Service Medal.

Principal Tuba **Steven Campbell**, a native of Texas, assumed his current post in fall 2005, after having performed with the Minnesota Orchestra on its 2004 European tour and in numerous subscription concerts. He performed two solos with the Orchestra during the 2010-11 season: Torbjörn Lundquist's *Landscape for Tuba and String Orchestra* at subscription concerts and George Kleinsinger's *Tubby the Tuba* at education and family concerts. Earlier, in summer 2006, he performed Victor Ewald's *Brass Quintet No. 3* in a Sommerfest chamber concert.

Campbell has participated in many music festivals, including the Colorado Music Festival, Tanglewood, National Repertory Orchestra, Spoleto USA, and Moab Music Festival, and has performed chamber music with such ensembles as Proteus 7 and the Empire Brass Quintet. In May 2014, he premiered James Stephenson's *Vast and Curious Trio for French Horn, Tuba, and Piano*, an international micro commission funded by numerous individual donors, performing with horn player Gail Williams at the International Tuba conference in Bloomington, Indiana.

Inspired by his parents, who are both musicians, Campbell became interested in music at an early age; his first teacher was his father, also a tuba player. Campbell went on to study at the University of Houston with David Kirk of the Houston Symphony, then completed a bachelor of music degree at the New England Conservatory in Boston, studying with former Boston Symphony musician Chester Schmitz. Campbell is also an educator. He is on the faculty of the University of Minnesota and St. Olaf College, and has given master classes and lectures in the United States and abroad. He lives in Minneapolis with his wife, Michelle, and their sons, Rowen and Leo.

**Timothy Mahr** holds a B.M. degree in composition and a B.A. degree in music education from St. Olaf College, as well as a master's degree in trombone performance, and a D.M.A. in instrumental conducting from The University of Iowa. He was elected to the American Bandmasters Association in 1993. An internationally acclaimed composer, Dr. Mahr received the 1991 Ostwald Award in the ABA Band Composition Contest for his work, *The Soaring Hawk*. Formerly Director of Bands at the University of Minnesota-Duluth and founding conductor of the Twin Ports Wind Ensemble, Dr. Mahr is the principal conductor of the Minnesota Symphonic Winds and is active as a clinician and guest conductor nationally and internationally. At the beginning of his career, he was Director of Bands at Milaca High School for three years. Notable commissions have come from the United States Air Force Band, the Music Educators National Conference, and the American Bandmasters Association. Over 40 of his works have been published, with many released on compact disc recordings and included on state contest lists.

Dr. Mahr is a past-president of the North Central Division of the College Band Directors National Association (1999-2001), has served on the Board of Directors of the National Band Association (1996-98) and was a founding board member of the Minnesota Band Directors Association.
