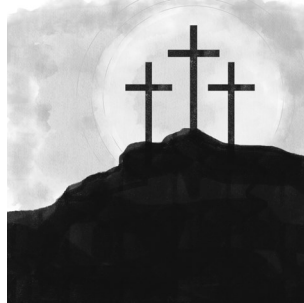


# SERVICE OF MORNING PRAYER FOR GOOD FRIDAY
