## **ABOUT THE DIRECTORS**

Sarah Hohenstein Burk is a versatile performer and recording artist on keyboard, violin, vocals, and percussion who has toured the U.S., Europe, and the Middle East with a wide range of ensembles and theater troupes. She directs and performs with her own jazz trio and 10-piece orchestra while also appearing with jazz, big band, R&B, gospel, classical, and world music groups. Having served as music director, conductor, composer, pianist, violinist, and arranger in over 100 theater productions across Minnesota and Europe, she continues to develop new works with Stages Theatre Company, the History Theatre, Theater Latté Da, and Green T Productions. Burk holds a B.M. in theory/composition with a jazz studies minor and a Master of Liberal Studies from the University of Minnesota, and has studied Latin jazz piano with Nachito Herrera and Afro-Caribbean percussion with Shai Hayo. She currently teaches jazz piano at St. Olaf College and has also taught at McNally Smith College of Music, St. Cloud State University, the College of St. Benedict, the University of Minnesota-Duluth, and Northland College.

**Dr. Joseph L. Jefferson** serves as Associate Professor of Music and Director of Jazz Ensembles/Applied Jazz Trombone at St. Olaf College, where he works at the intersection of jazz and classical traditions. His teaching and performing reflect a deep commitment to musical excellence, collaboration, and community. A Yamaha Performing Artist, Dr. Jefferson was recognized among Yamaha's "40 Under 40" Class of 2023 and received the 2022 Ellis Marsalis, Jr. Jazz Educator of the Year Award from the Jazz Education Network. He has shared the stage with artists such as Vanessa Williams, Sean Jones, and Nick Finzer, and has appeared as a soloist with ensembles including the Marshall University and George Fox University Jazz Ensembles. His work has been featured at the International Trombone Festival and the Jazz Education Network Conference, along with international performances and teaching residencies in Bermuda, Thailand, and Brazil. A regular clinician for Jazz at Lincoln Center, Dr. Jefferson approaches both performance and teaching with a belief in music's power to connect, inspire, and transform.
