During the ballad Jenny appears outside the window with Smith the constable and Mrs. Peachum. Song continues- apparently Jenny became pregnant long ago and both she and Mac began to roam. Macheath jumps out the window to avoid Smith's handcuffs. Mrs. Peachum and constables are waiting. The scene finishes outside. They take Mac away.

"Jealousy Duet" Polly and Lucy p42 Mrs Peachum arrives looking for Polly. They leave. Smith has fallen asleep. Lucy steals his keys and lets Mac out. They wake Smith and run. Chase ensues. Brown arrives and sits in the vacant cell. Peachum enters to collect his reward money and finds Brown. Blackout. "Second Threepenny Finale" p45 Macheath & Peachum & Mrs Peachum

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3	Scene 1: Peachum's Beggar's Outfit shop 3AM Friday Morning.	47	Beggars (painting sandwich signs). Peachum, Mrs. Peachum, Filch, Jenny	 in spots. The song is about the fact that people must first have food to eat- if not, they'll do anything required to get that first. "First feed the face and then talk right and wrong" End of Act 2. Blackout. Signage: Late the same night Peachum prepares for action. He plans to disrupt the coronation procession. Peachum: "And I discovered something. "Call from the Grave #1" (Mac) p55 Come and save Macheath Mac sends Matt and Jake to bring back \$\$ for a payoff. "Call from the Grave #2" Mac p56 Peachums, Jenny, Girls, Beggars, Matt, Jake, Rev burst in through the door. "Death Message" Mac p58. Mac wishes all would pardon him. "Passage to the Gallows" - music only. Mac walks up the steps to the Gallows. Macheath in the end is pardoned by the queen in honor of her coronation- instead of all watching Macs hanging, perhaps they will attend to the coronation.
